## Software Subscriptions

- Do you own your software?
- How many people use software subscriptions?
- Are you happy with this way of licensing software?
- Is it saving you money?
- Are you receiving upgrades?

### What is a perpetual license?

A perpetual licence is the "traditional" model used to purchase software. You pay for your software licence up-front and have the right to use it indefinitely.

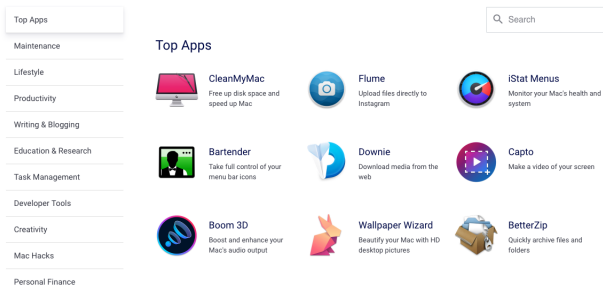
### What is subscription licensing?

You pay a per user fee, either monthly or annually, which allows you to use the software during the subscription term. The key difference being you don't own the software, instead you lease it. The subscription payment includes your software licences, access to support services and new versions of the software as they are released.

## Annual Subscription Cost (examples)

Microsoft Office	\$ 70 (1) \$ 100 (5)
Adobe Lightroom & Photoshop	\$ 120
1Password	\$ 36
TextExpander	\$ 40
Malwarebytes	\$ 40
SetApp	\$ 120
Robocall blockers	~ \$ 25
VPN services	~ \$ 60

## 32-bit Apps won't be supported in macOS 10.14

**32-bitCheck** – reviews installed apps, code bundles, and command to identify those which are 32-bit.

Keep watch for and install updates provided by developers.

This is a tool for checking which apps and other software are still 32-bit. Check the folders of your choosing, and can check just apps, or all bundles including plugins and other executable code. Generates text reports to help you prepare your Mac for macOS 10.14 later this year.
