


 - Screen Size
 - Ellipsis in View
 - My Model and Set Up
 - iPad Air (4th Generation) - My Primary Computing Device
 - iPad OS 15.5
 - Apple Magic Keyboard
 - Some commands are different with the on screen keyboard and some are not available.
 - Globe  and cmd  keys
 - Traditional App Switcher
 - Images
 - Logitech keyboard is another good option at ½ the price
 - Dynalist - Outline app I'm using

 - Views
 - Today View
 - Swipe from Left Side of Screen
 - Tap Edit at the bottom to add or remove Widgets
 - Notification Center
 - Swipe down from Top
 - Control Center
 - Swipe down from upper right corner
 - Spotlight/Search
 - Swipe down from middle of screen
 - Dock
 - Swipe up from bottom of screen
 - Continue swiping to reveal all open/recent apps
 - Home Screens
 - Multitasking
 - Three Types
 - Full Screen
 - Slide Over
 - Small floating windows on left or right of screen
 - Can be hidden until needed
 - Open multiple Slide Over windows and switch between them
 - Split View
 - Two windows
 - Limited ability to adjust sizes
 - Switching Between Multitasking Types
 - Drag and Drop
 - Ellipsis
 - Tap to make changes
 - Third App
 - Drag Slide Over up and hold to reveal all open apps
 - Swipe up to reveal Dock and drag the chosen app onto the screen
 - Open Apps
 - Swipe along the bottom of the screen to move to recent apps
 - Swipe up from the bottom to reveal all recent apps
 - Swipe up on an app to remove it
 - Shelf
 - When you switch to an app that has multiple windows open, the bottom of your iPad screen shows a shelf containing thumbnails of the app's windows.
 - Appears when you switch to an app or or tap the ellipsis
 - Drag and Drop
 - BTW, this works also with iPhone
 - Print to PDF
 - Widgets
 - Widgets are small bits of information
 - Add Widgets to the Today View and Home Screens
 - Different sizes and information details
 - Same size Widgets can be stacked
 - Add, move and delete widgets just like apps
 - Quick Note
 - Swipe up from the lower-right corner of the screen
 - Slide off to right to continue using the note
 - Adding Links
 - Apple Pencil
 - Show up in Quick Notes in sidebar
 - Customize or turn off in Settings > General > Gestures
 - App Library
 - Last icon in Dock
 - Last page of the Home screen
 - Hide Apps or entire Home screens
 - Press and hold an empty spot on the Home Screen to enter “jiggle mode”
 - Tap page indicator above the Dock
 - Select/deselect pages, tap Done
 - Moving Multiple Apps
 - Also works on iPhone
 - iPadOS 16
 - Weather App
 - Files
 - A new navigation button,
 - Sortable columns
 - Ability to change file extensions
 - An enhanced Open and Save panel making it easy to save files with related files and rename folders in-line to better.
 - Stage Manager
 - Only works with M1 Chip
